Kishwaukee College has Cooperative Educational Agreements and Joint Educational Agreements with various community colleges. These agreements allow Kishwaukee College district residents to attend other community colleges for programs not offered by Kishwaukee College. These agreements usually allow students to pay the sponsoring college's in-district tuition rate. Residents of other districts may enroll in occupational degree or certificate programs at Kishwaukee College that are not offered by their home district.

Non-resident students approved for chargeback tuition from their resident district will pay Kishwaukee College's resident tuition and their home district will reimburse Kishwaukee College for the balance of the non-resident tuition. Non-resident students attending Kishwaukee College without chargeback will pay the non-resident fees.

This responsibility is established by Article VI, Section 106-2 6-2, paragraph 3, of the *Illinois Public Community College Act*.

The approval of District 523 funds for the support of tuition for a resident of District 523 to attend another community college district for the pursuit of an educational program will be based upon the judgment of the Vice President of Student Services and/or his/her designated representative.
