Dual Credit in Kishwaukee Education Consortium Tuition & Fees

Tuition and fees are waived for Kishwaukee Education Consortium students enrolled in courses for which the College has an agreement to award dual credit.

Dual Credit – Courses taught at High Schools

Students enrolled in identified courses at high schools taught by qualified high school instructors using Kishwaukee College syllabi may receive Kishwaukee College credit for the course. Students are charged a flat \$50.00 registration fee. This fee would be waived for students currently receiving free or reduced-price lunch at their high school.

Students enrolled in identified courses at high schools taught by Kishwaukee College instructors where the high school is covering all costs related to the delivery of instruction may receive Kishwaukee College credit for the course. Students are not charged a registration fee by Kishwaukee College.
