The Board of Trustees of Kishwaukee College assesses out-of-state Illinois residents who attend Kishwaukee College a semester hour charge based on the per capita cost as determined for the preceding fiscal year. This charge shall be in addition to the regular tuition charged for each semester hour as set forth in the *Illinois Public Community College Act*. This out-of-state charge may be billed to the district residence in accordance with appropriate Statutes and the policies, rules and regulations of such district. It shall be the responsibility of the College administration to determine the amount of the charge to be assessed and to establish the amount that will constitute out-of-district charges at the appropriate time each year.

Foreign Country Resident

Students who are permanent residents of another country and apply for admission to Kishwaukee College as international students are classified as foreign student and charged the foreign student tuition rate.
