The Board of Trustees will have one (1) non-voting member who is a student enrolled in the College as provided by 110 ILCS 805/3-7.24 of the *Illinois Public Community College Act*.

The student trustee will be elected by the student body to a one-year term beginning April 15 of each year, as provided by the law. The non-voting student trustee has all the rights and privileges of the other trustees except in the manner of voting. The student trustee has the right to make and second motions and attend executive sessions. The student trustee may also cast an advisory vote on all matters on which the Board votes.

Requirements of Student Trustee:

- Student must have successfully completed 9 credit hours and be actively enrolled in 6 credit hours during their time of service
- Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Student must not have any Code of Conduct violations
- Student must be in good academic standing
- Student may not be a full-time or part-time employee of the College; not including student employment

If the elected student member vacates the position for any reason, every effort should be made to select the successor within thirty (30) days of Board of Trustees action on the vacancy. The selection process for filling a vacancy in the student trustee position shall involve the Student Government Association. The Student Government Association in conjunction with the Director of Student Involvement, Vice President of Student Services and the Coordinator of Student Activities will develop the procedure for such appointment.
