Kishwaukee College is committed to providing a positive and safe educational setting for students and the community. All persons visiting the campus are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with standards of the College, and to comply with campus rules, city and county ordinances, appropriate educational code sections, and state laws.

Visitors are welcome at all public meetings held at College facilities. However, no person, including children, relatives or friends of students or employees shall attend any class, laboratory, field trip or any other instructional or educational activity for which they are not registered or enrolled.

Unaccompanied/unauthorized minor children are not allowed on the campus, except when they are enrolled in a class or receiving services offered by the College. To protect children from possible injury and to maintain a safe, secure learning environment, children are not permitted in classes and are not to be left unsupervised anywhere on campus, including employee work areas.
