Freedom of speech, discussion and expression of all views is permitted within Kishwaukee College subject to requirements for the maintenance of order. Support of any cause by orderly means, which is not in violation of law and which does not disrupt the operation of the College, nor interfere with the rights of others is permitted. Kishwaukee College retains the right to assure the safety of individuals, the protection of property and the continuity of the educational process.

In accordance with the Illinois Statute, “Interference with public institution of higher education,” the policy of Kishwaukee College is to prohibit acts which interfere with College operations. Kishwaukee College policy provides for freedom of speech, expression and lawful assembly at the College. As with such, venues are provided on campus for the lawful expression of opinions, demonstrations, and protests. Kishwaukee College retains the right to regulate the time, place and manner of demonstrations to assure the safety of individuals, the protection of property and the continuity of the educational process.

Persons or organizations will be permitted to use these designated areas only after application stating the purpose thereof with due and proper references and promising compliance with the rules, procedures and restrictions established by the College. The Vice President Student Services (or designee) is responsible for this area.
