

## 2-Year Planner for an Associate in Arts (AA) Degree

The Art & Design concentration is intended for students planning to transfer to a four-year college or university after completing a two-year degree (A.A. or A.S.) at Kishwaukee College. This is an example course sequence for students interested in Art and is not represent a contract or guarantee course availability. All graduation and degree requirements for the A.A. or A.S. degree must be satisfied (see the Graduation Requirements section of the Kishwaukee College Catalog). Students pursuing the A.A. or A.S. degree within this area are advised to determine the bachelor degree requirements of the college to which they plan to transfer. Many colleges and universities have specific requirements for transfer students. Art schools may require a portfolio for admission. Additional courses in math, reading and English may be required based on placement scores.

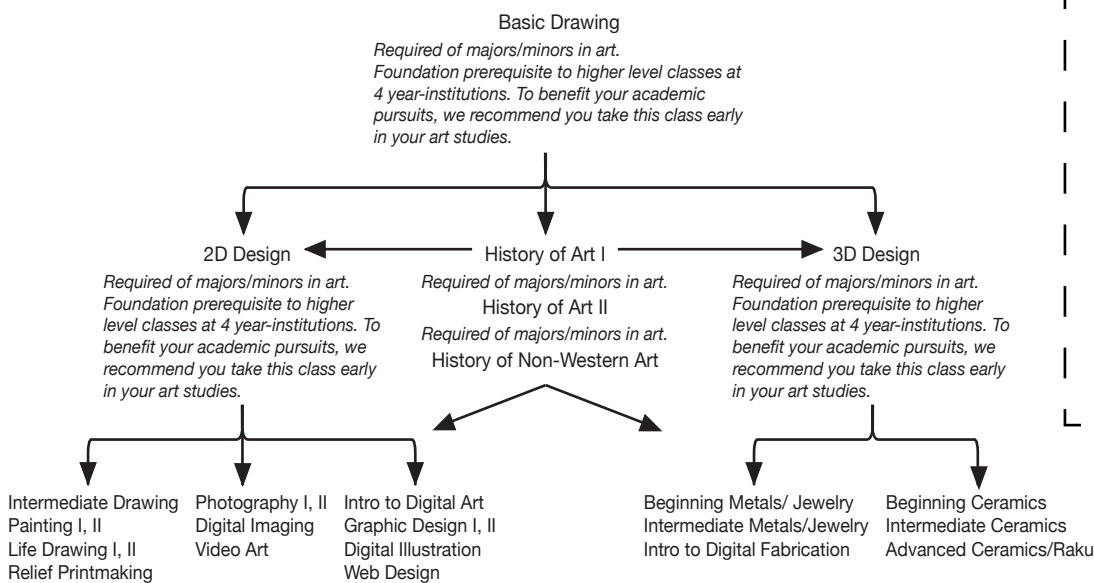
