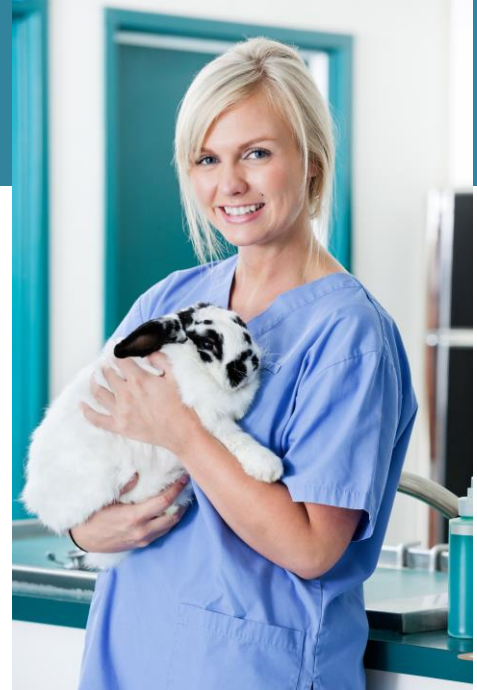

Veterinary assistants are critical members of a veterinary staff who have been trained to assist veterinarians and veterinary technicians with medical procedures on sick and injured animals. Veterinary assistants are also trained in examination, customer relations, and veterinary hospital office procedures.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), employment in the veterinary assistant field is expected to grow 9 percent from 2014-2024, which is much faster than the average for all occupations. Veterinary assistants and laboratory animal caretakers work mainly in clinics, animal hospitals, and research laboratories.

Median annual wages of veterinary assistants was \$25,250 in May 2016.

This program includes 112 hours of class time and 60 hours of externship at an animal hospital.
